Biometric Release Form

Bullsbrook College uses a state of the art "sign in" system to improve attendance record keeping. This system can use both scans and "Biometric" identification. The "Biometric" uses the finger and it's image to uniquely identify each person. The system does not create or store a fingerprint image. This form of identification is called Biometrics and is often used to log into Smart Phones and Laptops.

Once this system is implemented your son or daughter can sign in and out of school using the Bar Code scans or Biometrics.

How does the Kiosk operate?

Using scanning or finger biometrics, students can sign in and select from a set of reasons for arriving or leaving school. This includes late arrivals and leaving school for off site classes or work related activities.

How do the Biometrics operate?

Using a built in finger scanner, the software scans the fingerprint to create and store individual templates of unique points that identify each student. When a student requires a pass for leaving or entering the school, the software again scans the finger and looks for a match in the data base.

What about the privacy of Biometrics?

The software does not store a copy of the fingerprint. Instead the computer program creates a numeric template of the unique fingerprint characteristics. This template is stored via the software on the school's server and is deleted when the student is no longer active at the school. At no time is a fingerprint image stored. The image cannot be recreated and used for other agencies or systems.
