## ENROLMENTS for 2019

In Western Australia, children can start their education in Kindergarten, however compulsory schooling starts the following year in Pre-primary.

**Friday 20 July** is an important date in your child's education.

Applications for enrolment for 2019 need to be made if your child is:

- starting Kindergarten – 4 years old by 30 June, 2019
- starting Pre-primary, the first year of compulsory school – 5 years old by 30 June, 2019 (but hasn't been at Bullsbrook College or Community Kindergarten for Kindy this year)
- starting in Year 7 at Bullsbrook College, the first year of secondary school, but hasn't been at Bullsbrook College in Year 6
- changing schools

Every child from Pre-primary to Year 12 is guaranteed a place at their local public school.

**Applications close Friday 20 July, 2018.**

*This date is important because it assists us in planning for 2019. Appointment of staff is based upon projected enrolments.*

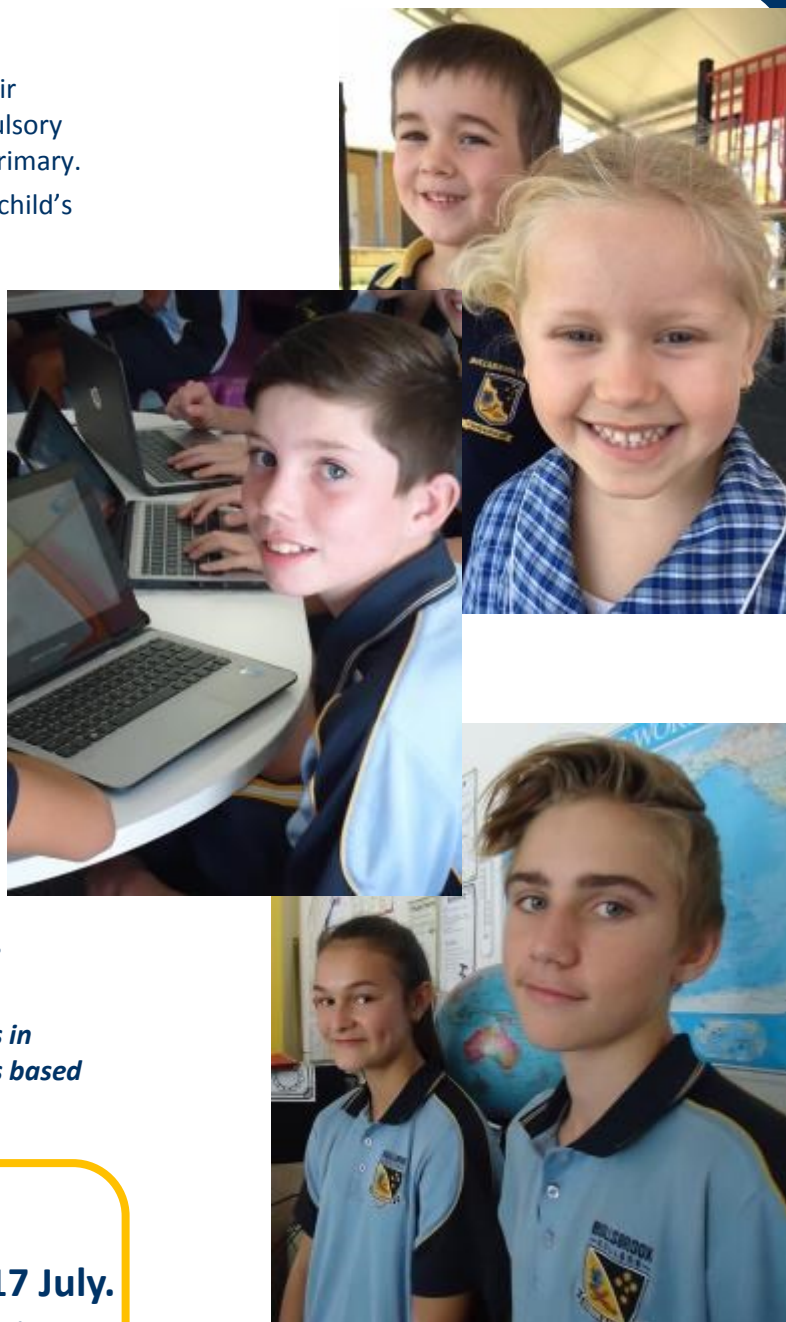
**DAY 1 for Term 3 is Tuesday 17 July.**
