<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Girls and Boys - Bullsbrook College blue polo shirt navy blue/gold/sky blue with embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Unisex shorts, navy with Bullsbrook College embroidered on left leg.</li> <li>• Unisex Jacket – navy with embroidered crest on front and gold embroidered Bullsbrook College on back.</li> <li>• Girls dress with embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Girls skort - Pleated navy skirt/short.</li> <li>• Unisex navy track pants. Embroidered Bullsbrook College in gold on left leg.</li> <li>• Unisex House polo shirt in House colours. House name and text screen printed on back.</li> <li>• Hat (appropriate sun protection)</li> </ul> <p><b>OTHER INFORMATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Footwear and socks</b> – footwear is to be enclosed for all students. Students who are not wearing closed footwear are unable to participate in practical classes for safety reasons. Socks preferred white or navy blue.</li> <li>• <b>Jewellery</b>– Students are permitted to wear minimal jewellery that is unobtrusive.</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Library/Sport bags with Bullsbrook College crest are also available upon request.</b></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Girls and Boys - Bullsbrook College polo shirt sky blue/navy with embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Girls and Boys - shirt/blouse, sky blue with embroidered crest. <i>Students representing the school at special events (eg speech nights, leadership conferences etc) will be required to wear formal uniform eg dress, pants, formal shirt (shorts not suitable).</i></li> <li>• Girls and Boys “Bomber Jacket”, navy with gold/white/sky striped band and embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Girls skirt, navy (now obsolete but still part of the dress code)</li> <li>• Girls skort, navy.</li> <li>• Girls navy sports style short with embroidery on leg.</li> <li>• Girls dress shorts, navy (now obsolete but still part of the dress code).</li> <li>• Girls dress with embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Girls tights, navy.</li> <li>• Boys navy sports style short with embroidery on leg.</li> <li>• Girls and Boys V neck jumper, navy with embroidered crest.</li> <li>• Girls and Boys shorts, navy.</li> <li>• Girls and Boys House polo shirts. House name screen printed on back. (Can be worn in PE.)</li> <li>• Hat (appropriate sun protection)</li> </ul> <p><b>OTHER INFORMATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Footwear and socks</b> – footwear is to be enclosed for all students. Students who are not wearing closed footwear are unable to participate in practical classes for safety reasons. Socks should be white or navy blue.</li> <li>• <b>Physical Education</b> – students may wear the College’s Physical Education polo shirt <b>during Physical Education classes</b>. This is also to be worn for Inter School Carnivals. <b>Not for normal school wear.</b></li> <li>• <b>Track suit tops and pants</b> - only to be worn for sporting/physical education (PE) activities.</li> <li>• <b>Jewellery and Cosmetics</b> – Students are permitted to wear minimal jewellery that is unobtrusive. Students are encouraged to avoid wearing make up. Make up that is discreet and appropriate for a school environment will be considered acceptable. (EG: Heavy and dark eye liner/eye shadow is not acceptable.)</li> <li>• Only white tops should be worn underneath the uniform.</li> <li>• <b>Leavers’ Jacket</b> – optional choice for Year 12 students only.</li> </ul>
