

DRESS CODE

By adopting a school uniform which is smart, durable and economical, we are ensuring a safer environment which supports positive expectations for behaviour and tone.

Wearing a uniform:

- ◇ ensures the safety of students through easy identification;
- ◇ promotes a positive school image;
- ◇ engenders a sense of school pride;
- ◇ encourages equity amongst students; and,
- ◇ prepares students for the workplace, where conformity to dress and safety codes is expected.

The Uniform Policy and Dress Code at Bullsbrook College applies at all times - to all students from Kindergarten to Year 12 - when students are required to wear the school uniform before, during and after school. There are no exceptions to this policy.



The Physical Education (PE) shirt is available from the Uniform Shop for PE lessons. This is not compulsory. Students are able to wear casual, comfortable, appropriate clothing other than the PE uniform for PE lessons. However, the PE uniform may NOT be worn during the normal school day. It is not part of the school uniform for anything other than PE lessons.
