COVID-19 UPDATE

As you will be aware, we are now in a situation where being COVID safe in our practices continues to be very important. Secondary students and adults on site must wear masks. Primary students are exempt.

Please note the following by way of providing further clarity.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Parents and Carers are very welcome on site provided they:

- Wear a mask
- Practise 1.5 metres physical distancing between adults
- Follow good hand and respiratory hygiene practices
- Adhere to the 2 square metre per adult venue capacity rule (assembly on Wednesday pm)

All visitors to the school must sign in as we are required to be able to provide contact tracing information if requested by WA Health. Whilst we do have a QR code, we feel more confident with the mandatory sign-in register. However, please use the SafeWA app elsewhere as an important assistance for contact tracing should things change.

PRIMARY ASSEMBLY WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON, 30 JUNE

At the time of writing, the primary assembly being held on Wednesday afternoon will proceed. Please note that, if you are attending this, the above conditions apply.

SCHOOL CANTEEN

This is open for business as usual with extra cleaning.

Please ensure that you stay home if you are unwell, and that your children are not sent to school if they are unwell. COVID testing should occur if you or your children show signs of a runny nose/headache as these are also symptoms for the COVID virus. Getting tested is very important.
