COVID-19 UPDATE

As planned, the Perth and Peel post-lockdown restrictions have been significantly eased further from 12.01am last Saturday, 1 May.

The easing of restrictions sees Perth and Peel move closer to the return of pre-lockdown life, but a small number of transitional measures will remain in place until Saturday, 8 May. As you know, schools remain open and masks are required for all staff and secondary school students. Teachers can remove masks to teach.

Venue capacity limits have also been eased and parents/carers are able to attend school activities such as assemblies and events. Masks are mandatory for parents/carers to wear indoors and outdoors where physical distancing is not possible and all visitors on site, including parents, are required to sign in on a register.
