SPECIFICATIONS

Netbook/Laptop:

- CPU: Core i5 or AMD equivalent
- RAM: 8GB of memory or more
- Storage: 256GB SSD or better
- Screen: at least 1920 x 1080 resolution
- Battery: a battery that will hold at least a 6-hour charge
- Windows Version: Win10 Professional

Tablet:

- Screen: 8" TFT LCD display which offers sharpness, clarity and more natural looking colours
- RAM: 4 GB of RAM which ensures that you can effectively multitask between apps
- Storage: should include storage capacity of 32 GB with the option to add an additional 512 GB via micro SD
- Camera: outward facing camera - 8 MP for clear photos and front facing camera - 2 MP
- CPU: Quad-Core processor to ensure that single apps load quickly, animations play smoothly and you can browse through your media with ease.
