While all items are conveniently available through Campion, you are not obligated to use this supplier. Please note that your child will need these specified materials daily, and you may need to replenish items like pens or pencils throughout the year. Additionally, all students from Pre-Primary to Year 6 must have the math workbook as an essential requirement for their math education. In the event a student arrives at school without a math workbook, one will be provided, and the associated charges will be applied to their student billing account.

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#### **VOLUNTARY ADDITIONAL REQUESTS**

Each year the P&C endeavours to provide the school with resources that further support the work of the school and contribute to the wellbeing of your child. Recent additions provided by the P&C include refrigerated drink bottle refilling stations and table tennis tables. This is in addition to operating the School Canteen for the benefit of all students.
